

Youth of the Month YOM Requirements 2021 – 2022



- A) Nominees must be a high school senior who will be graduating in the spring semester of 2022 and must be of legal status in the United States.
- B) Nominees should state their role in improving their community and/or living conditions.
- C) Nominees must participate in a school activity / activity (band, athletics, cheerleading, student council, or other clubs) and/or community service (Boys & Girls Club, coaching, fundraisers, etc.). **A nominee who is unable to fulfill this requirement due to work obligations is still eligible to receive this award**
- D) Nominees must maintain at least a **95-grade point average or better** and must not have any conduct problems in school and/or the community.
- E) Nominees are nominated for this award by an educator and selected by a committee composed by counselors/administrators at their respective schools.
- F) All applications must be typed using Times New Roman, font size 12.
- G) Selected YOM students must submit a self-portrait (wallet size minimum) in formal attire, such as a graduation photos or other formal photos. **Selfie-type photos cannot be used**
- H) All nominees must agree to allow the use of their photo and application information for Laredo Sector Border Patrol to use on social media.

Selection Procedure

- A) A teacher will nominate eligible students utilizing the Youth of the Month (YOM) packet.
- B) Teachers will submit all nominee packets to the school counselor for review. Each school is responsible to arrange/form a selection committee. The selection committee is responsible for selecting the student to receive the YOM award.
- C) All selections packets are **due on the 9th of each month**. For the month of May, packet will be due on the first week of April 2022 (Subject to Change). The Border Community Liaison Unit will remind to submit packets via e-mail. **Packets should be submitted to: LRTBCLGML@cbp.dhs.gov** and **Rene.Alejandro@cbp.dhs.gov**.
- D) Youth of the Year 2021-2022 selections packets are due by the third week of April 2022. Packets should be submitted to: <u>LRTBCLGML@cbp.dhs.gov</u> and <u>Rene.Alejandro@cbp.dhs.gov</u>.
- E) By the end of the school year, each school will have nine YOM recipients. Each school will be responsible for selecting the best student from their previous submitted YOM recipients, to be considered for the Youth of the Year award.
- F) At the end of the school year, Border Patrol will gather a selection committee to select the Youth of the Year.
